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

D.C. Market overview

The Washington, DC metropolitan region remains one of the most resilient in the nation, with an economy propelled by strong growth in the business and professional service sectors, as well as substantial economic stability provided by the federal government. The region has seen the emergence of a more diverse and dynamic economy that features one of the country's largest technology clusters and rapidly growing biotech and aerospace industries. Positioned just minutes outside of Washington, DC, National Harbor attracts millions of visitors each year, contributing significantly to the local economy. In 2019, the total economic impact of travel and tourism in Maryland was approximately \$18 billion, with visitor spending supporting numerous jobs and businesses in the state. As of 2021, visitor spending in Maryland reached \$26.4 billion, a 32% increase from 2019 levels, indicating a strong rebound off of the COVID-19 pandemic and for future years to come.

National Harbor/Oxon Hill

The Oxon Hill/Alexandria area offers excellent connectivity and accessibility. Highway accessibility is a key advantage of the Oxon Hill/Alexandria area, making it an even more attractive location. The region is well-connected to major highways, ensuring effortless travel for both guests and staff. Interstate 95, one of the busiest highways on the East Coast, passes near National Harbor, providing convenient access for travelers arriving from cities north and south, including Washington, D.C., Baltimore, and Philadelphia. Additionally, Interstate 495, also known as the Capital Beltway, surrounds the area, connecting it to the greater D.C. metropolitan region. This allows for seamless transit between different parts of Maryland, Virginia, and the District of Columbia, further enhancing convenience for guests and facilitating efficient transportation logistics for hotel operations. The excellent highway infrastructure in the Oxon Hill/Alexandria area ensures demand from near and far, contributing to its desirability and continuous growth.





Transportation

The region is well-connected by major highways, allowing for seamless commutes. Beyond the allure of National Harbor, guests can explore the rich history and cultural landmarks of Alexandria, such as the historic Old Town, George Washington's Mount Vernon, and the Torpedo Factory Art Center. This enticing blend of urban convenience, accessibility, and cultural significance creates a compelling proposition for a hotel in the Oxon Hill/Alexandria area.

National Harbor is nearby to Amtrack transportation offerings, such as the Alexandria Station, which provides convenient services to major cities such as Philadelphia, New York City, and Boston. From National Harbor, travelers are able to take a taxi service to the Alexandria Station, which is approximately 10 miles away. In addition to the Amtrak system, the closest Metrorail station to National Harbor is the Branch Avenue Station. The Green Line allows travelers to take the Metrorail to D.C.'s Union Station, where Amtrak and other provider connections accessible and allow access to major cities.





Ronald Reagan Washington National Airport

The Hotel benefits from its location just 8.8 miles away from Ronald Reagan National Airport. Primarily serving flight connections to major cities across the United States, Ronald Reagan Washington National Airport is a hub for several national airlines, including American Airlines. In 2022, Reagan National Airport broke a passenger record of 24 million, driven by heavy leisure demand and proving a strong recovery off its COVID-19 pandemic levels.










The MGM National Harbor

Washington D.C.


With over \$1.7 trillion in business travel as of 2021 in Washington D.C., the city has evolved into an economic hub for nearly every industry sector. Conferences, tradeshows, and many other industry-relevant events have drawn visitation from across the world, gathering groups to travel to and conduct business efforts throughout the City's most notable event spaces. A commonly recognized event space known as the Walter E. Washington Convention Center is a prominent multi-faceted, 2.3 million square-foot convention center that hosts a wide range of events ranging from the International Conference on Robotics & Automation, which hosts approximately 5,000 annual attendees, to the American Psychiatric Association Annual Meeting which hosts over 12,000, and many more. The Hotel's proximity to Washington D.C. provides an opportunity to capture additional room night demand due to overflow relating to events of this scale. 


